- You should only apply if you consider yourself detail-oriented, very patient, and eager to work in a collaborative environment

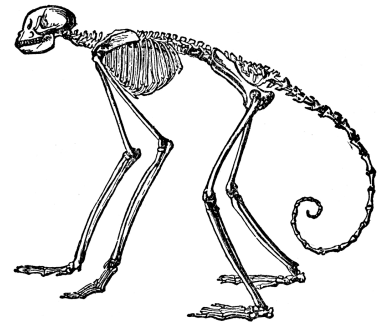
Requirements
